Workers' Compensation Pennsylvania

Workers' Compensation Information

The Pennsylvania workers' compensation law provides wage loss and medical benefits to employees who cannot work, or who need medical care, because of a work-related injury.

Benefits are required to be paid by your employer when self-insured, or through insurance provided by your employer. Your employer is insured by ICW Group P.O. Box 509039 San Diego, CA 92150, phone number 800.877.1111. This information is to be posted at your company's primary place of business and its sites of employment in a prominent and easily accessible place, including, without limitation, areas used for the administration of first aid.

- You should report immediately any injury or work-related illness to your employer.
- Your benefits could be delayed or denied if you do not notify your employer immediately.
- If your claim is denied by your employer, you have the right to request a hearing before a workers' compensation judge.
