



CLARIFICATION ON FIRST AID TREATMENT IN CALIFORNIA

In December 2016, the Workers' Compensation Insurance Rating Bureau (WCIRB) clarified the reporting requirements for first aid claims in California. Effective January 1, 2017, employers and insurance carriers are required to report all costs for any medical care associated with all first aid claims, regardless of whether the employer or insurance carrier paid for the first aid medical services.
